**University of South Carolina**

**(2 blocks away)** The University has a beautiful campus, here are several places to check out:

- [The Historic Horseshoe](#) Take a walk through main campus and the horseshoe.
- [Anne Frank Center](#): The University of South Carolina is the Official U.S. Partner of the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam, and the only partner site in North America.
- [McCutchen House](#) The historic McCutchen House is open to the public for lunch during the University of South Carolina regular fall and spring semesters, 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m, Tuesday through Friday.

**Night Out**

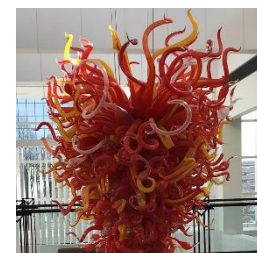

**Museums**

**(<1 mile away)** Columbia has great museums to check out and close by to the conference!

- “The [South Carolina State Museum](#) offers four floors of exhibits that are all about South Carolina, ranging from history to technology to science and natural history, from dinosaurs to the Revolutionary War to airplanes. It also features an incredible planetarium and observatory that lets you safely look right into the sun.”
- “The [Columbia Museum of Art](#)'s permanent collection includes precious pieces from around the world, including the only fresco by Renaissance artist Botticelli outside of Italy and a spectacular Dale Chihuly glass sculpture that hangs over you as you enter the museum. And lest you think an art museum is only for grown-ups, the CMA has [wonderful programming for kids and families](#), too.



### **Riverbanks Zoo**

**(3.6 Miles away)** The [Riverbanks Zoo](#) is over 150 acres with a botanical garden, restaurant, with over 4,000 types of plants, and over 2,000 types of animals.



### **Live Shows and Concerts**

**(0.4-2 miles away)** Check out all of these close by venues before heading to Columbia as you may want to take in a show or live music. Koger Center is only 0.4 miles away and has great Broadway musicals!
